**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO.09**  
Series of 2020

**AN ORDER TEMPORARILY BANNING THE ENTRY OF SWINE, PORK, PORK-RELATED PRODUCTS AND BY-PRODUCTS (EDIBLE AND NON-EDIBLE), WHETHER RAW, PROCESSED OR COOKED, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO BOAR SEMEN, WHETHER PRESERVED, EXTENDED, OR FROZEN , IN ANY FORM AND AMOUNT, AND REGULATING THE ENTRY OF LIVE HOGS, COMING FROM THE AFRICAN SWINE FEVER AFFECTED AREAS WITHIN THE 1-7-10 KILOMETER COVERAGE PROTOCOL IN THE COUNTRY , AND ALL FROM INFECTED FOREIGN COUNTRIES THROUGH ALL POINTS OF ENTRY IN THE MUNICIPALITY, AND PROHIBITION OF SWILL FEEDING IN RESPONSE TO THE IMMINENT THREAT OF THE ASF INFECTION.**

Whereas, African SWINE FEVER continues to spread in many parts of Luzon causing massive economic losses;

Whereas, that there is an imminent threat of African Swine Fever virus that may spread and infect the premises of the municipality in such proportion that would urgent, immediate and integrated action and response;

Whereas, in order to prevent the entry of ASF disease in the municipality and to complement with the massive campaign for the ASF infection dissemination, the Local Chief Executive issued this Order directing the temporary banning of pork meat and pork-related products ( edible or non-edible in the municipality).

**NOW THEREFORE, I, ALVERA VERONICA R. RIMANDO, MD, FPSMS,RMT** by virtue of power vested in me by law as Municipal Mayor, do hereby direct all concerned government officials and swine stakeholders to be vigilant in their areas of responsibility. Further, all are hereby alerted and advised to prepare protective measures to prevent the entry of swine diseases in the municipality by observing the following:

**Section 1. For Municipal/Barangay LGUs:**

- Conduct information, education and communication (IEC) activities for the prohibition and ill-effect of feeding food wastes/swill (*Lamaw*) ;
- Ensure that food wastes/swill feeding is not practiced by swine raisers;
- Conduct regular monitoring and surveillance on health and status of swine
- Ensure that illegal meat products (fresh frozen, processed) are not being sold in the market;
- Report any suspicious cases of mortalities in pigs in their areas to the MAGRO for verification.

**Section 2. For Swine Raisers:**

- Prohibit feeding pigs with swill (*Lamaw*) coming from hotels, restaurants, carinderia, and other food establishments;
- Conduct information, education, and communication (IEC) activities for the prohibition and ill-effects of feeding food wastes/swill;
- Practice strict bio-security measures in the farms;
- Report any suspicious cases of mortalities in pigs in their areas to the MAGRO for verification

**Section 3. For meat Processors and vendors.**

- Ensure that there shall be no meat processing and/or illegal meat products (referred as banned/prohibited meat products).

**Section 4. For Hotel and Restaurant Operations and others food establishment**

- Ensure that the table left-overs (referred as food wastes/swill or "*Lamaw*" shall the properly disposed and shall not be provided to swine raisers as feed for their pigs within the municipality.

**Section 5. Funding, All expenses to support the activities of the African Swine Fever Task Force shall be taken from any available fund.**

**Section 6. Effectivity**

This Order shall take effect immediately.
