EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 13

Series of 2020

AN ORDER DECLARING THE SUSPENSION OF CLASSES AND WORK IN ALL LEVELS BOTH PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS AND OTHER SCHOOL-BASED ACTIVITIES IN THE MUNICIPALITY MACO

WHEREAS, the President, His Excellency **RODRIGO ROA DUTERTE**, declares the Philippines under the State of Public Health Emergency through Proclamation No. 922 Series of 2020;

WHEREAS, the Department of Health (DOH) confirmed the local transmission of Corona Virus Disease (COVID 19) and raised the level to "Code Red" Sublevel Two (2);

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Maco considers the welfare of the people of Maco to be a topmost priority and therefore finds it necessary to take precautionary measures that will prevent local transmission of the said disease;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ALVERA VERONICA R. RIMANDO, MD, FPSMS, RMT, Municipal Mayor of Maco Davao de Oro, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order;

SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF CLASSES

The Department of Education Maco District is directed that the remaining activities of School Year 2019-2020 be accelerated and suspend classes and work effective March 17, 2020 until further notice. Coverage are the ECCD schools, pre-school, elementary, junior and senior high schools and other technical schools. As to specific instructions for teachers and school personnel regarding their duties and responsibilities when the class suspension takes effect on Tuesday, they shall refer to the Public Schools District Supervisor and the District Coordinating Principal.

SECTION 2. CANCELLATION OF SCHOOL-RELATED MASS EVENTS AND GATHERINGS

All events that require mass gathering, such as, but not limited to, graduation and moving-up ceremonies, JS proms, and PTA assemblies must be postponed indefinitely or cancelled. Schools are encouraged to hold such

activities after the State of Public Health Emergency is lifted by the National Government or upon the advice of DepEd authorities.

SECTION 3. COMPLETION OF ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

Department of Education District of Maco and the technical school shall issue a separate order detailing the mechanisms for the completion of academic requirements that may be hampered by the issuance of this order.

SECTION 4. KIDS AT HOME POLICY

While classes are suspended, all school children shall remain at their homes. The Philippine National Police, Traffic Aide, and the Inter-Agency Task Force shall also ensure that no school children are seen roaming in streets and in public places (e.g plazas, parks) after the effectivity of class suspension, unless supervised by a parent or guardian.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
